

How to Navigate the Delco Website as a Referee

Below is a quick tutorial about where to now find things on the Delco web site www.delcosoccer.org

Please remember that as assignors you should only be dealing with the club delegate and not the coaches

Only games changes approved by the league and posted in red on the schedule posted online are allowed to be made. Clubs are not permitted to make changes without league approval

Delegates have been instructed to be in contact with their referee assignors on a weekly basis to insure the accuracy of the games you are assigning referees for. If you do not hear from your delegates by 9/6/08 please let me know asap!

League Contact Information

If you need to contact me for any issues pertaining to the Delco League you can contact me at anytime at 610-513-3539 or at mec1210@aol.com. I want to be contacted immediately if there are any issues that you can not resolve with the delegates. If you do not hear back from within a day please resend your email, I make it a rule to try and answer all emails within 24 hrs.and most times sooner than that.

Delegate contact information

To find the updated list of delegates' names, emails and phone numbers

go to www.delcosoccer.org

Click on the left hand side of the front page on the "league information" link

then click on the "list of delegates" There is also a "list of coaches" contact info link as well.

Modified rules for Delco games

go to www.delcosoccer.org

Click on the left hand side of the front page on the "league information" link

then click on the "game day rules" and the "game rules addendum"

It is Delco's rules that passes be checked before each game. Referees should report if this is not done by the coaches. Please read carefully the addendum for the sidelines for this year. Both PAGS and Delco have adopted the same sideline rules for this year. Our U 9 and U 10 have some newly modified rules as well.

Schedules on Line and approved changes

For a link to access the master schedule

go to www.delcosoccer.org

Click on the left hand side of the front page on the "league information" link

then click on the "2008 schedule" link

Here you will see a feature labeled "changes"

This feature will allow you to view only the changes that have been approved by the league.

You can sort this list numerous ways, home club, date, game number etc.

You can sort any list by clicking on the header title at the top of any column.

For a quick link to just sort the schedule by field and date

You can also access the schedule by field only under your [referee access links](#) found under the [league member](#) access link as well.

Supplemental Game Reports

here you will find the "incident link" which is actually the supplemental game report you will need to report
cards, incidents, etc.
Please be sure to provide an email address for contacting you if we have questions about the game.
Only our referee liaison will have access to these email addresses!

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Weather Cancellations for the League

If the league is going to cancel the entire schedule for the day it will be posted online at
www.delcosoccer.org. The decision will be made by Dick Burke the VP of competition as early as
possible. The coaches were told in a meeting last night that if their fields are closed when the league has
not shut down play they **MUST** contact their opponents and referee assignors **IMMEDIATELY!** If a game
is canceled
at the field by the referee because the field is determined to be unplayable then that must be reported to
the league as well.

Referee no shows

The coaches have been instructed that if no referee shows for their game, the game must still be played
with a substitute volunteer referee agreed upon by both coaches. Both coaches should report that to the
league and to Goose Gosselin so that he can get in touch with the referee assignor to find out what
happened.

If only 2 referee show for an assigned three man system at no time is a two man on the field system
allowed to be used. A volunteer club linesman must be agreed upon and used. This also must be
reported to the league.
