1. Games are 25 minute halves with a final sixty minute championship game

2. STANDINGS FORMAT

A. The first place team will be that team accruing the most total points. Second place team accrues the 2nd highest number of points. Points will be awarded as follows:

Win 3 points Tie 1 point Loss 0 points
 Shut-out1 point
 (a 0 – 0 game counts as a Tie, 1 pt. only) AND (a shut-out 1 pt., only applies to a WIN: total of 4 pts max)

B. The **tie breaking** procedures are the following, in order:

1. Most wins.
2. Result of Head-to-Head Competition.
3. Fewest Goals Scored Against By Opponents.
4. Goal differential (max. 3 per game)
5. Time Permitting, a shoot out Conducted by the Game Referee and the Tournament Director (U12, U14)

Championship Game

- A. Two teams with the highest point totals after all tie breakers are applied will play in the championship game
- B. If a tie occurs in final championship game, there will be, progressively until a winner is determined,
 - a 5 minute overtime period, then if needed
 - a second 5 minute overtime then if needed
 - a penalty kick shootout , minimum of 5 shooters and if tied after five, continues until a winner is decided

3. AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the **First Place and Second Place** Team Rosters in each age category

4. STATS

- A. Game referees will report game results to the tournament director or appointed site coordinator.
- B. The tournament director or appointed site coordinator will document each game result on the tournament bracket boards and masters.
- C. **NO COACH, PLAYER, PARENT OR SPECTATOR WILL BE PERMITTED TO MAKE ANY GAME SCORE/RESULT ENTRIES ON ANY OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT PAPERWORK OR BRACKET BOARDS.**

5. This is a patch/pin exchange festival.
